

HIGHLIGHTS

- > The export earnings from cashew and allied products during the year 2012-2013 were Rs. 4046 Cr. (US \$ 747 Mln).
- According to the data received from DGCI & S, Kolkata compiled by the Council, the export of cashew kernels during 2012-2013 was 1,00,105 MT valued at Rs. 4046.23 Cr. (US \$ 747 Mln.) as against 1,30,869 MT. valued at Rs. 4383.82 Cr. (US \$ 916 Mln.) exported during 2011-12.
- ➤ The export of cashew nut shell liquid from India during 2012-13 was 9,192 MT valued at Rs. 29.84 Cr. (US \$ 6 Mln). The export of cashew nut shell liquid during 2011-12 was 13,528 MT valued at Rs. 59.46 Cr. (US \$ 12.4 Mln).
- > The registered office of the Council was shifted to Cashew Bhavan, Kollam during the year.
- > The Council started enrolling Associate Members to bring more cashew processors into exports.
- > The total membership in the Council as on 31-3-2013 was 217 including associate members.
- > 'Cashewotsavam' a meeting of all stake holders of cashew in the country along with Cashew Machinery Expo was organized at Kollam in September 2012.
- ➤ The first Logistic meet for Cashew, 'LOGISTIKAJU' was organized at Kollam during March 2013 to enable the exporters plan their raw cashew nut imports and Cashew kernels export shipment scheduled operations.
- During 2012-13, the Council participated in 3 international exhibitions, two trade delegations and attended three International Conferences. Council also organized two BSMs abroad.
- ➤ For the first time in the history of CEPCI, Council organized 'Cashew Pavilion' in two International fairs viz. SIAL & Gulfood 2013. Council members exhibited in individual stalls under the CEPCI pavilion.
- A sum of Rs 18,79,907/- was reimbursed to 27 member exporters towards participation in international fairs, trade delegations, etc. during 2012-13.
- A sum of Rs. 50 lakhs was released to 18 member exporters as grant-in-aid for the Modernization & Diversification under the Five Year Plan Schemes.
- > The Council received 156 Trade Enquiries at its office during 2012-13 which were circulated among Council members.
- > The CEPC Laboratory & Technical Division, Kollam analyzed 4373 samples during 2012-13.
- > The CEPC laboratory was recognized as an Approved Research Centre for Doctoral research by Kannur University and University of Kerala.





REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE OF ADMINISTRATION ON THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE COMMITTEE AND ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2013

I. EXPORT PERFORMANCE

1.1. General

- 1.1.1 As per the export-import statistics published by the DGCI&S, Kolkatta, the share of agricultural products in the total export earnings of the country during 2012-13 (April 2012 to March 2013) is 7.46% and cashew kernels ranked 11^{th} among them contributing 3.34%. This accounted to 0.25% of the total foreign exchange earnings of the country through exports.
- 1.1.2 According to DGCI&S final figures, the total export of cashew kernels from India during 2012-13 was 1,00,105 M.T. valued at Rs.4046.23 Cr. (US \$ 747 Mln). It showed a decrease of 23.51 % in quantity, 7.70% in value in rupee terms and a 18.44% in US \$ terms in comparison with the export of 1,30,869 M.T. cashew kernels valued at Rs. 4383.82 Cr. (US \$ 916 Mln) during 2011–2012.
- 1.1.3 The export of cashewnut shell liquid / Cardanol from India during April to March 2013 was 9,192 M.T valued at Rs. 29.84 Cr. (US \$ 6 Mln.). There was a decrease of 32.05% in quantity, 49.82% in value in



Rupee terms and 55.58% in US \$ terms compared to the export of $13,528\,$ MT of Cashew Nut Shell Liquid valued at Rs. $59.46\,$ Cr. (US \$ $12.40\,$ Mln.) during 2011-2012.

1.1.4 Due to the centralization of export/import data in various Custom Houses, we have not been receiving data from the Customs Houses regularly. Hence trade statistics compiled from Customs data are not included.





2.2. Major Markets for cashew kernels


2.2.1. The major markets for Indian cashew kernels during 2012-2013 were USA, U.A.E, Netherlands, Japan, Saudi Arabia, France, U.K. ,Spain, Germany, etc.. There was considerable increase in the exports to countries like Saudi Arabia, Korea, Iran, Malaysia, Korea Dp.Rp., etc.

2.3. Export of cashew kernels to different zones:

2.3.1. Out of the total quantity of cashew kernels exported during 2012-2013, 31.28% were to American Zone. European Zone accounted for 26.15%, West Asian Zone for 25.46%, South East & Far East Asian Zone for 13.45%, Oceanic Zone for 0.72% and African Zone for 2.93%.

4. PRODUCTION OF RAW CASHEWNUTS IN INDIA

4.1. India continued to be the largest producer of raw cashewnuts in the world. The other main producing countries are Vietnam, Brazil, Tanzania, Ivory Coast, Guinea Bissau, Mozambique, and Indonesia. According to estimates by DCCD, the production of raw cashewnuts in India during 2012-2013 was 7,28,474 M.T. as against the estimated production of 6,92,000 M.T. during 2011-2012.

Estimates of Indian Production of Raw Cashewnuts During 2010-2011 to 2012-2013



5. IMPORT OF RAW CASHEWNUTS

- 5.1. The total raw cashew nuts imported into India during 2012-2013 was 8,92,365 MT valued at Rs.5331.74 Cr. and that during 2011-2012 was 8,09,825 M.T. valued at Rs.5338.64 Cr. The unit import price for raw cashewnut was Rs. 59.75/kg during 2012-2013 as against Rs. 65.92/kg during the previous year. (Source: DGCI&S, Kolkotta)
- 5.2. The major sources of raw cashew nut import were Ivory coast, Benin, Tanzania, Guinea Bissau, Ghana, Indonesia, etc.

6. IMPORT OF CASHEW KERNELS INTO INDIA

- 6.1. Cashew Kernels, plain as well as roasted & salted are being imported into India from other producing countries, since last few years. These are low priced/low quality cashew kernels and compete with our domestic industry. The Council has already taken up with the Govt. requesting to impose maximum (of 70%) import duty for the same.

8. EXPORT/IMPORT POLICY

8.1. Export of Cashew Kernels and Cashew Nut Shell Liquid & Cardanol

8.1.1. Export of Cashew Kernels, CNSL and Cardanol could be carried out by any person having an IE Code. Cardanol continued to be included in list of items under Minor Forest Produce.

8.2. Export Incentives

- 8.2.1. The Duty Drawback rate remained at 1% of FOB value.
- 8.2.2. VKGUY for Cashew Kernels, CNSL and Cardanol continued to be the same as 5% of FOB value.
- 8.2.3. The Council continued its efforts for increase in the VKGUY rates for value added cashews.

9. PRODUCTION DEVELOPMENT

- 9.1. The Council has been representing at all forums, the need for increasing the domestic production of raw cashew nuts in the country.
- 9.2. According to estimates by the Directorate of Cashew nut & Cocoa Development, the production of raw cashew nuts in India during 2012-13 was 7,28,474 MT as against the estimated production of 6,92,000 MT during 2011-12.

10. SALES TAX / VALUE ADDED TAX / CST / SERVICE TAX

10.1. The Council continued to pursue with the Central / State Governments to exempt or reduce the rate of VAT for Raw Cashewnuts and cashew kernels in order to make our cashew kernels more competitive in the international markets.



10.2. The Council has been representing to the Govt. to exempt Cashew Council and Cashew exports from the purview of Service Tax.

11. REGISTERED OFFICE OF THE COUNCIL

11.1. The Registered Office of the Cashew EPC of India was shifted from Cochin to Cashew Bhavan, Kollam during the year, with approval of the Ministry of Commerce and the Registrar of Companies, Kerala.

12. PUBLICITY & ADVERTISEMENT

- 12.1. During 2012-2013, the Council continued to publish its magazines, the monthly Cashew Bulletin and also brought out following brochures / publication during the year.
 - a. Directory of Indian Cashew Exporters
 - b. Brochures and Posters for participation in International fairs.

13. CONVENTIONS / EXHIBITIONS / TRADE DELEGATIONS

- 13.1. The Council sponsored a Trade Delegation to USA from 22nd to 28th April 2012. The delegation participated in the AFI Annual Convention which was scheduled from 26th to 29th April, 2012 at USA.
- 13.2. Before the AFI Annual Convention, the delegation had business meetings with the prospective cashew nut buyers, roasters, importers, salters, traders, etc. in USA at New York. The delegation was led by Mr. P. Sundaran, who is also a member of Committee of Administration of the Council & Managing Partner of M/s. Sreelekshmi Cashew Company, Kollam. Mr. K. Sasi Varma, Executive Director & Secretary was the official representative.
- 13.3. The Council participated in the INC Annual Congress 2012 held at Singapore on 18th to 20th May 2012. The Congress saw the participation of various stakeholders of the global tree nut industry and was a good platform for business networking. Shri. Hari Krishnan R Nair, Chairman and Mrs. Sree Rajmohan, Joint Director represented the Council. Twenty two CEPCI member companies also participated in the event.
- 13.4. CEPCI successfully organized a Buyer-Seller Meet of Indian Cashew Exporters and International Buyers / Importers on 21st May 2012 at Singapore. This was the first International BSM organized by the CEPCI abroad. The meeting witnessed participation of 19 Buyers / Importers from around the world. 22 Council members who are Cashew Kernel Exporters from India participated in the Meet. Importers/Buyers from 9 countries including Singapore were present. Shri. Amitesh Bharat Singh, the First Secretary (Com) of the High Commission of India in Singapore, attended the meet. Representatives of the Singapore Indian Chamber of Commerce & Industry also participated in the Buyer Seller Meet.
- 13.5. The Council participated in the VINACAS Golden Cashew Rendezvous 2012 from 22nd to 24th May 2012 at Nah Trang, Vietnam. Shri. Hari Krishnan R Nair, Chairman and Mrs. Sree Rajmohan, Joint Director represented the Council.
- 13.6. The 59th session of UNECE Specialised meeting on Dry and Dried Produce was held on 18th & 19th June 2012 at Geneva. Shri. Hari Krishnan R. Nair, Chairman, CEPCI represented the Council.
- 13.7. The Council participated in the 19th SAITEX & Africa's Big Seven Exhibition, from 15th to 17th July 2012 at Johannesburg, South Africa. The Indian participation was organized by the India Trade Promotion Organisation (ITPO). The High Commission of India, Pretoria and the Consulate General of India,



Johannesburg organized a Buyer Seller Breakfast Meet for the Indian Companies at the Convention Centre on 17th July 2012 to explore the possibilities of mutual business cooperation and joint ventures. Shri. Hari Krishnan R. Nair, Chairman, CEPCI and Smt. P. K. Jaya, Accounts Officer, CEPCI represented the Council.

- 13.8. The Council participated SIAL International Food Fair held at Paris, from 21st to 25th October 2012. The Council had set up a cashew pavilion in SIAL-2012 and four member exporters viz. M/s. Wender's Foods Pvt. Ltd., M/s. K Subraya Kamath & Sons, M/s. A S Cashew Exporters and M/s. Nila Exports exhibited in independent stalls. This was a historical moment, as for the first time, our member exporters exhibited their products in independent stalls under Council's umbrella. The Council also had a 15 sq. meter stall and about twelve other member exporters participated through our stall. Ms. Sree Rajmohan, Joint Director, CEPCI organized Council's participation at SIAL.
- 13.9. The Council participated in the Gulfood 2013, Dubai, UAE from 25th to 28th February 2013. This year, the Council has made a landmark in its participation in the international fairs by organising a "CEPCI Pavilion" and at this fair, 7 member exporters exhibited their products individually under Cashew Pavilion along with the Council. About 25 member exporters also participated through the Council's stall. Shri Hari Krishnan Nair, Chairman and Mrs. Sree Rajmohan, Joint Director represented the Council.
- 13.10. The Council organized a Networking Meeting / Reception on 26th February 2013 at the Dubai International Convention & Exhibition Centre on the sidelines of Gulfood Fair for facilitating one to one discussions between Indian Cashew Exporters and Overseas buyers.
- 13.11. Report on the Council's participation in the various exhibitions and delegations along with the trade enquiries received were circulated among members for information and follow-up.

14. ASSISTANCE FOR EXPORT PROMOTION ACTIVITIES TO EXPORTERS

- 14.1. Market Development Assistance (MDA) Schemes
- 14.1.1. A sum of Rs. 18,79,907/- was distributed to member exporters as grant towards participation in international fairs, trade delegations / BSMs during 2012-13.
- 14.2. Five Year Plan Schemes
- 14.2.1. A sum of Rs. 50 lakhs was released to 18 member exporters as grant-in-aid for the Modernization & Diversification under the Five Year Plan Schemes.
- 14.2.2. The Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Commerce, Government of India has approved the XII Plan Scheme proposals of the Council containing two schemes viz.,
 - 1. Process Mechanization and Automation of Cashew Processing Units
 - 2. Quality up-gradation and Food Safety Certifications

The Scheme period will be from 2012-13 to 2016-17. Under the scheme, members are eligible for grant equivalent to 33.33% of the total eligible investment. The maximum total grant available for member exporter is Rs. 100 lakhs for Process Mechanization and Automation of Cashew Processing Units and Rs. 5 lakhs for Quality up-gradation and Food safety Certifications. For Associate members this would be Rs. 10 lakhs and Rs. 2.5 lakhs respectively.

- 15.8. ARECA made a presentation during the meeting for the benefit of CEPCI members. An MoU was also signed between ARECA and CEPCI for maintain the smooth cooperation between the two organizations.

- 16.4. Along with the AGM, CEPCI organized "Cashewotsavam 2012" an Expo for the Cashew Industry and dealers of related materials and services, at the same venue on 7th & 8th September 2012. Eleven companies had set up stalls at the exhibition centre. During the technical sessions on 7th afternoon, eminent persons, well versed in the cashew field spoke on their perception on various aspects of mechanisation relevant to the Cashew Industry. The main presenter was Mr. Prakash Rao Kalbavi, CEO, Kalbavi Cashews, Mangalore, Karnataka.
- 16.5. The Council organized an Open-House Meet for the stake-holders in cashew from all major Cashew producing and processing states, at Hotel Mandovi, Panaji, Goa on 10th October 2012. The meeting was followed by a Networking Dinner which was sponsored by the Goa Cashew Manufacturers Association. Members from the Karnataka Cashew Manufacturers Association (KCMA), Goa Cashew Manufacturers Association (GCMA), Orissa Cashew Processors Association, Maharashtra Cashew Manufacturers Association, Palasa Cashew Manufacturers' Association, Andhra Pradesh participated in the Meeting.
- 16.6. Micro Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) organized a Management Development Programme in Export Procedures and Documentation from 1st to 6th October 2012 in association with the Kerala State Small Industries Association, Kochi at the main hall of Kerala State Small Industries Association at Palarivattom, Kochi. 16.14. LOGISTIKAJU 2013 -The Indian Cashew Logistics Meet was organised by the Council at Hotel Quilon Beach, Kollam, Kerala, India on 7th & 8th March 2013. A total of 120 delegates representing Port / Shipping Agencies, CHA's, Raw Cashew Agencies, etc along with CEPCI members.

17. TRADE ENQUIRIES

- 17.1. During 2012-2013 the Council received 156 (foreign 68 and Indian 88) trade enquiries directly from parties interested in cashew kernels/cashewnut shell liquid/ allied products and offers for supply of raw cashewnuts. All these enquiries and offers were circulated among the Council Members for necessary follow-up.
- 17.2. Trade enquiries received at the Council's stand in the international exhibitions were also passed on to the members for necessary action at their end.

18. PROBLEMS TAKEN UP WITH AUTHORITIES

- 18.1. Council represented to the DGFT to allot a higher rate of VKGUY for value added cashew kernels.
- 18.2. Council took up the issue of under–invoiced and mis–declared import of Cashew Kernels into India with the MoC as well as with CBEC and had suggested to fix minimum base-price for computing the import duties for such imports.
- 18.3. Council has taken up with the MoC and Ministry of Health & FSSAI, the issue of FSSAI for RCN requesting exemption for RCN from the purview of FSSAI.
- 18.4. Council had taken up with the MoC, for getting authorization for the Council to issue of Certificate of Origin under ASEAN- FTA for cashew and allied products.

19. CEPC LABORATORY AND TECHNICAL DIVISION

19.1. Analytical Services

- The CEPC Laboratory & Technical Division at Kollam, Kerala, established in 1997, continues to provide analytical services to the Indian cashew industry and ensure the quality of cashews exported from the country.
- 19.1.2. The laboratory is equipped with the state of the art technology to undertake the analysis of physical, chemical and microbial parameters including pesticide residues, aflatoxin and heavy metals in cashew and other food products.
- 19.1.3. The laboratory follows internationally accepted test methods for analysis and to validate the analytical methods adopted, the laboratory regularly participates in check sample/validation programmes organized by international/national agencies.
- 19.1.4. The analytical and scientific expertise available at the laboratory are being imparted to exporters, traders, farmers, research organizations, and other industrial and education institutions.
- 19.1.5. During the year 2012-13, 4373 samples were analysed in the laboratory and results furnished.

19.2. Testing in Processing Units (Gas Analysis)

19.2.1 The gas analyzer of the laboratory was taken to various cashew processing units, and the quantity of oxygen, carbon dioxide and nitrogen in filled tins / pouches were tested. 18 units were covered under this project during the year.



19.3. Collection of Samples from field (Swab samples)

19.3.1 Six hundred and eighty nine swab samples, four water and fifty one air samples were collected from different units and were tested in the laboratory.

19.4. Major Instruments Commissioned

- 19.4.1 Under the ASIDE Scheme of the Govt. of India, assistance of Rs.5 Cr. was granted to the laboratory for upgradation of the facilities and 35 new equipments were purchased for strengthening the analytical facilities. During the year 2012-13 the following equipments were commissioned.

 - b) VIDAS Screening of Pathogens
 - c) VITEK Identification of organisms
 - 2. LC MS MS

19.5. ACCREDITATION / RECOGNITION / APPROVAL

19.5.1.1 The Laboratory is accredited under ISO/IEC: 17025 by NABL (National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories), Department of Science & Technology, Government of India for "Biological and Chemical testing". The accreditation status was maintained as per the quality system. The re-assessment of the laboratory was conducted on 4th & 5th August, 2012 by NABL. Internal audits were conducted as per schedule. The laboratory has also participated and conducted various inter laboratory comparison programmes.

19.5.2 BIS Recognition

19.5.2.1 The recognition granted to CEPCI laboratory by the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) for the testing of Packaged Drinking Water, including pesticide residue as per IS 14543:2004 was maintained. Twenty four Packaged Drinking Water samples received from BIS were analysed and results submitted.

19.5.3 Approval from Kerala State Pollution Control Board

19.5.3.1 CEPCI laboratory is approved as 'A' grade Commercial category laboratory for analysis of quality / pollution parameters for water / waste water and solid waste by the Kerala State Pollution Control Board.

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE OF ADMINISTRATION ON THE BALANCE SHEET AND INCOME & EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT FOR THE YEAR 31ST MARCH 2013

The Members of the Committee of Administration have pleasure to present the audited Balance Sheet and Income & Expenditure Account of the Council for the year ended 31st March 2013. As required by the Ministry of Commerce in their letter No. 6(5) MDA/86 dated 19-5-1956, Receipts and Payments Accounts for the year have also been attached.

The Council is an organization working on "No-Profit-No-Loss" basis. The trade contribution for a year is collected purely on a provisional advance basis and added to the advance contribution carried over from the previous years. The trade contribution required for a year is taken from the gross amount, the balance carried over to the next year. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. Revenue Recognition

- a) The Council follows accrual system of accounting based on historical cost concept in relation to its income and expenditure except subscription to the council's publications, interest on staff loan, sale of publications and fees from training course conducted at CEPC Lab at Kollam.
- b) Full amount of entrance fee is taken as income of the Council as was done in the previous year.
- c) As regards house building /vehicle advance are concerned, the repayment is first appropriated to principal and then to interest.
- d) The Council is an organization working on "No Profit- No Loss" basis. The trade contribution for the year is collected purely on a provisional advance basis and added to the advance contribution carried over from the previous year. The trade contribution required for a year is taken from gross amount and the balance is carried over to the next year.

2. Retirement benefit

Gratuity: - Liability on account of gratuity is funded through a scheme administered by the Life Insurance Corporation of India and insurance premium is paid on the basis of actuarial certificate and the confirmation is received from the insurer that the contribution payable to the insurer is appropriate liability for the year.

Provident Fund: - The Contribution payable by the Council for the year is charged to the Income & Expenditure Account.

3. Fixed Assets

Fixed assets disclosed in the accounts are stated at historical cost and reduced by depreciation till date. All cost relating to the acquisition and installation of fixed assets have been capitalized.

4. Depreciation

In respect of all assets depreciation has been charged to revenue account on the cost/WDV of assets at the rate prescribed in the schedule XIV to the companies act, 1956 and on addition pro-rata basis.

5. Inventories

Stock of chemicals and controlled item have been valued at cost and as certified by the Council.

6. Foreign Exchange

Amount received or spent in foreign exchange have been accounted as per the guidelines of Reserve Bank of India.



7. Government Grants

Grant relating to the depreciable fixed assets has been treated as deferred income and is recognized in the Income and Expenditure account on a systematic and rational basis over the useful life of the assets in proportion in which depreciation on the assets is charged as Accounting Standard-12 issued by ICAI.

Grant related to revenue is recognized on a systematic basis in the Income and Expenditure Account of the year necessary to match them with related cost of which the grant is intended to compensate.

8. Contingent Liability

No amount has been recognized as on date of Balance Sheet for which the Council would be contingently liable and hence no provision in this regard.


